Torrance Boulevard Storm Drain Improvement

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Dear Homeowner/Resident:

This Notice is to advise you that construction of a new storm drain on Torrance Boulevard, between Crenshaw Boulevard and Madrona Avenue, will begin on **Friday, August 1st**. Normal working hours are between 7:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. on weekdays. Additionally, it will be required to work on some weekends at the intersections of Crenshaw Boulevard and Maple Avenue. Weekend work hours are between 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. The work will be ongoing for approximately 5 weeks.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS & ACCESS – AUGUST/SEPTEMBER 2008

Torrance Boulevard will be reduced to one lane in each direction between Madrona Avenue and Crenshaw Boulevard. Delays are expected. Left-turns in and out of Torrance Boulevard at Date Avenue, Elm Avenue and the Torrance Boulevard Service Road near Eriel Avenue and Madrona Avenue will be prohibited on a 24-hour basis during the work.

For weekend construction at the intersections with Crenshaw Boulevard and Maple Avenue, additional travel lanes will be closed and left-turns will be prohibited throughout the entire weekend. We recommend you identify an alternate route. Should you need assistance identifying an alternative route to/from your home, please contact the Engineering Manager at the number listed below.
