NOTICE OF STREET CONSTRUCTION

Torrance Boulevard Rehabilitation

Dear Citizen,

On **Monday, April 13th**, the City's contractor, Sully Miller Contracting Company will begin pavement reconstruction on Torrance Boulevard between Anza Avenue and Hawthorne Boulevard. Work hours are between 7:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday. Please note that the final paving is scheduled to occur on **Saturday, April 18th** in order to minimize traffic impacts to businesses and residents.

SPRINKLERS

Please refrain from using sprinklers in the parkway areas along Torrance Boulevard during this week as the water could damage the new pavement. The use of parkway sprinklers along the Torrance Boulevard service road will not be prohibited as this area is far enough away from the paving area.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS AND ACCESS

Traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction on a 24-hour basis during the construction. Access to side streets and driveways will be accessible during construction. However, there will be short periods (approximately 2 hours) on some days when access will be prohibited in order to complete work. Driveways along the Torrance Boulevard service road will not be affected.

Delays are expected, so we recommend you identify an alternate route when possible. We thank you for your cooperation and patience during the construction. We remind everyone to use caution, reduce your speed and observe the traffic restrictions. Although inconveniences are expected, it is our goal to complete the work as quickly as possible.
