

# **Volleyball League**

## **Frequently Asked Questions**

### **How much is the program?**

Our volleyball league fee is \$69.

### **How do I register for the program?**

Flyers are given out to the Torrance elementary and middle schools. You can register for our volleyball league online, by phone, mailing, faxing, or walking in the permission slip. Please note that there are deadlines for each form of registering.

### **What season is volleyball played?**

Volleyball is played in the spring, April – June.

### **How many players are on a team?**

There are 12 players maximum permitted per team.

### **How do you break down the teams and what are the age groups?**

Volleyball is a co-ed sport. Teams are separated by grade level, then by school, or geographic location. If there are not enough players from your school, they will be combined with a neighboring school that is also short of players. For volleyball, there are two divisions. The Junior Division consists of fourth and fifth graders. The Senior Division consists of sixth, seventh and eighth graders.

### **How do you select coaches?**

All of our coaches are volunteers taking their time to make this a good experience for everyone participating. All coaches are fingerprinted and complete a background check.

### **Can I request a team, coach, or a friend to be on my team?**

We do not accept requests.

### **How do I bring in a team?**

For volleyball, we do not accept brought-in teams in any of our divisions.

### **When and where are practices and how many are there per week?**

Practices are held based on the coach's availability; either at a local park or school. There are usually one to two practices per week.

### **When and where are games played?**

Games are played on Saturdays, for all divisions, at the Dee Hardison Sports Center at Wilson Park (2400 Jefferson Street). Game times may vary; schedules are given out at the beginning of the season.

### **How long is the program and how many games are there?**

The program is eight weeks long and there are eight games.

### **What does my child wear?**

Participants will wear the City of Torrance uniform shirt and appropriate athletic footwear to the sport. Coaches will meet with the parents to determine the rest of the uniform.

### **Is it necessary to have volleyball experience?**

No, it's not necessary to have volleyball experience. Our goal is to help provide an opportunity for children to play in an organized recreational Youth Volleyball League. We teach the basic rules, strategies and skills involved in playing volleyball. We also encourage good sportsmanship and fair play.

### **Do you offer refunds?**

No full refunds are given. You have the option to request either 80% refund or 100% credit to your City of Torrance account. Please note that there are deadlines for requesting a refund.
