

# Auxiliary Fire Fighter

## Internship Program

The Torrance Fire Department Auxiliary Fire Fighter program provides Fire Academy graduates an opportunity to apply their acquired skills and gain insight, while preparing for a fire service career.

### Auxiliary Fire Fighters:

- Respond to emergencies.
- Assist with Fire prevention inspections.
- Maintain apparatus, equipment and stations.
- Participate with training and public education.

### After successful completion of this one year training program, participants will be equipped:

- Enter a career as a Fire Fighter and be eligible for the opportunity for consideration as a Torrance Fire Fighter.
- Possible recommendation to Paramedic School.



### What is the schedule?

Participants in this internship program will be expected to commit to volunteer (unpaid) one year of service. The schedule for this program is three (3) 24 hour shifts per month.

### How do I qualify for the Internship Program?

- Graduation from a California State Certified Fire Academy.
- California Emergency Medical Technician -1 Certification with Los Angeles County EMT Scope of Practice.
- A valid California driver's license.
