RESTAURANT BURGLARIES

September 23, 2014



DETAILS: On Saturday, September 13, 2014 between 3:01-3:06 AM, the above-pictured suspects forced entry via a front door pry to **CAPICOLA SANDWICHES**, 3160 PCH, pried open the interior office, lightly ransacked, attempted to pry open a second interior door inside the office that led to a secondary office and fled with victim's property.



S1 On Thursday, July 31, 2014 at 9:17 PM, **CAPICOLA SANDWICHES**, 3160 PCH was burglarized by suspects (pictured at left and right) who smashed out the front glass door, pried open the office door, ransacked the office and pried open the cash registers.



SUSPECT DESCRIPTION: September 13th crime – **Suspect-1** Black male adult, 30-40 years old, medium build wearing a tan short sleeved collared shirt, dark pants, gloves on both hands. **Suspect-2** Black male adult, 30-40 years old, heavy, wearing a white short sleeved collared shirt, dark pants, white shoes, gloves on both hands - both suspects were carrying crowbar-type tools.

July 31st crime – **Suspect-1** Black male adult, 35-40 years old, mustache, wearing a dark beanie, tan/brown jacket, black pants **Suspect-2** Black male adult wearing a dark beanie, dark jacket, dark pants and dark shoes.

SUSPECT VEHICLE: September 13th crime - Black, 4-Door sedan (unknown make or model), fled eastbound PCH and out of sight.



July 31st crime - Possibly older Honda Accord, 4-Door (vehicle in image at left)
