Major Traffic Collision

On December 11, 2014, at approximately 2:41 a.m., officers from the Torrance Police Department responded to a major traffic collision at the intersection of Torrance Boulevard and Cabrillo Avenue.

On arrival, officers discovered that a vehicle traveling eastbound on Torrance Boulevard lost control at the intersection of Cabrillo Avenue, where it struck a curb and overturned, coming to rest on the Union Pacific Rail Road Train Tracks, located on the south side of Torrance Boulevard. The driver and passenger of the vehicle were transported to a local hospital where the passenger succumbed to his injuries and the driver was treated for minor injuries.

The eastbound lanes of Torrance Boulevard at Cabrillo Avenue were closed to all traffic for approximately five hours during the investigation.

This collision is being investigated by the Torrance Police Department's Traffic Division under the command of Captain Rodney Irvine, Commander of the Special Operations Bureau.
