## **Fatal Traffic Collision**

**Incident # 150001111**

On January 6, 2015, at approximately 9:00 p.m., officers from the Torrance Police Department responded to a double fatal traffic collision on Pacific Coast Highway, east of Madison Street.

On arrival, officers discovered that a silver Honda Accord driven by a 28-year-old male, traveling eastbound on Pacific Coast Highway, had collided head on with a silver Toyota Corolla. The 19-year-old male driver and the 20-year female passenger of the Toyota Corolla both succumbed to their injuries from the collision. The male driving the Honda Accord sustained major injuries and was treated by Torrance Fire Department personnel at the scene. He was subsequently transported to a local hospital where he is listed in critical condition.

Both eastbound and westbound lanes on Pacific Coast Highway were closed for approximately four hours during the investigation.

This collision is being investigated by the Torrance Police Department's Traffic Division under the command of Captain Rod Irvine, Commander of the Special Operations Bureau.
