**Fatal Traffic Collision**

**February 18, 2013**

On February 18 2013, at approximately 11:30 am, officers from the Torrance Police Department responded to a major traffic collision, with injuries, in the 2800 block of Sepulveda Boulevard.

On arrival, officers discovered that a motorcycle traveling eastbound on Sepulveda Boulevard had collided with a van that had just exited from a private driveway. The motorcyclist was treated by paramedics and transported to a local area hospital where he was later pronounced dead. The name of the motorcyclist has been withheld pending notification to a next of kin.

The driver of the van was not injured.

Sepulveda Boulevard between Crenshaw Boulevard and Maple Avenue was closed for approximately three hours while investigators completed their investigation.

This collision is being investigated by the Torrance Police Department's Traffic Division under the command of Captain Bernard Anderson, Commander of the Special Operations Bureau.
