Farmers Bank Robbery

On Thursday, December 4, 2014 at 1253 Hrs, the above-pictured suspect entered the Farmers Bank located at 22400 Hawthorne and presented a demand note (not recovered). No weapon was threatened or seen. The suspect fled to the rear of the location and was last seen eastbound on 224th St toward Ward. The loss was approximately \$3,000.00.

The suspect is described as a Caucasian male , 38-42 yrs, 603-605/thin, Brown/Brown, clean-shaven, clean-cut, large nose w/ mole on left side, white baseball cap, red long sleeve t-shirt or lightweight sweater, dark skinny jeans, black converse shoes. The suspect vehicle is possibly a white Honda or Toyota 4 door with a sunroof.

Detectives learned through their investigation that the suspect went to a nearby store and shopped for several hours immediately after committing the robbery. The suspect also changed his shirt two times as well from the red to a dark color and finally the white shirt as pictured. See attached photos.

This incident is being investigated under the command and direction of Captain Rod Irvine of the Special Operations Bureau.
