**Prescription Drug Drop off**  
**April 27, 2013**

On Saturday, April 27, 2013, from 10 am-2 pm, the Los Angeles Field Division of the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) will coordinate a nationwide one-day collaborative effort to remove potentially dangerous controlled substances from our nations' homes. The National Take-Back Initiative will provide those who have accumulated unwanted and unused prescription drugs a great opportunity to dispose of them safely.
