



City of Torrance NOTICE OF INTENTION TO FILL A VACANCY ON THE TORRANCE CITY COUNCIL DISTRICT 4 BY APPOINTMENT

The Torrance City Council took action at their regular meeting of July 21, 2026 to fill by appointment the unexpired term of District 4 Councilmember Sharon Kalani who accepted the office of Mayor on July 14, 2026.

The term of office is from appointment on August 25, 2026 until the regular municipal election scheduled for March 7, 2028 results are certified and the new elected officials are installed.

All applicants must be 18 years of age, reside within the City of Torrance District 4 and be registered voters within the City of Torrance District 4 at the time of appointment. Appointee must live in District 4 the entire term of appointment.

The City Council will interview candidates separately and each applicant will have the opportunity to present their qualifications and discuss their candidacy with the City Council.

Applications must be returned by 5 pm, Thursday, August 13, 2026.
