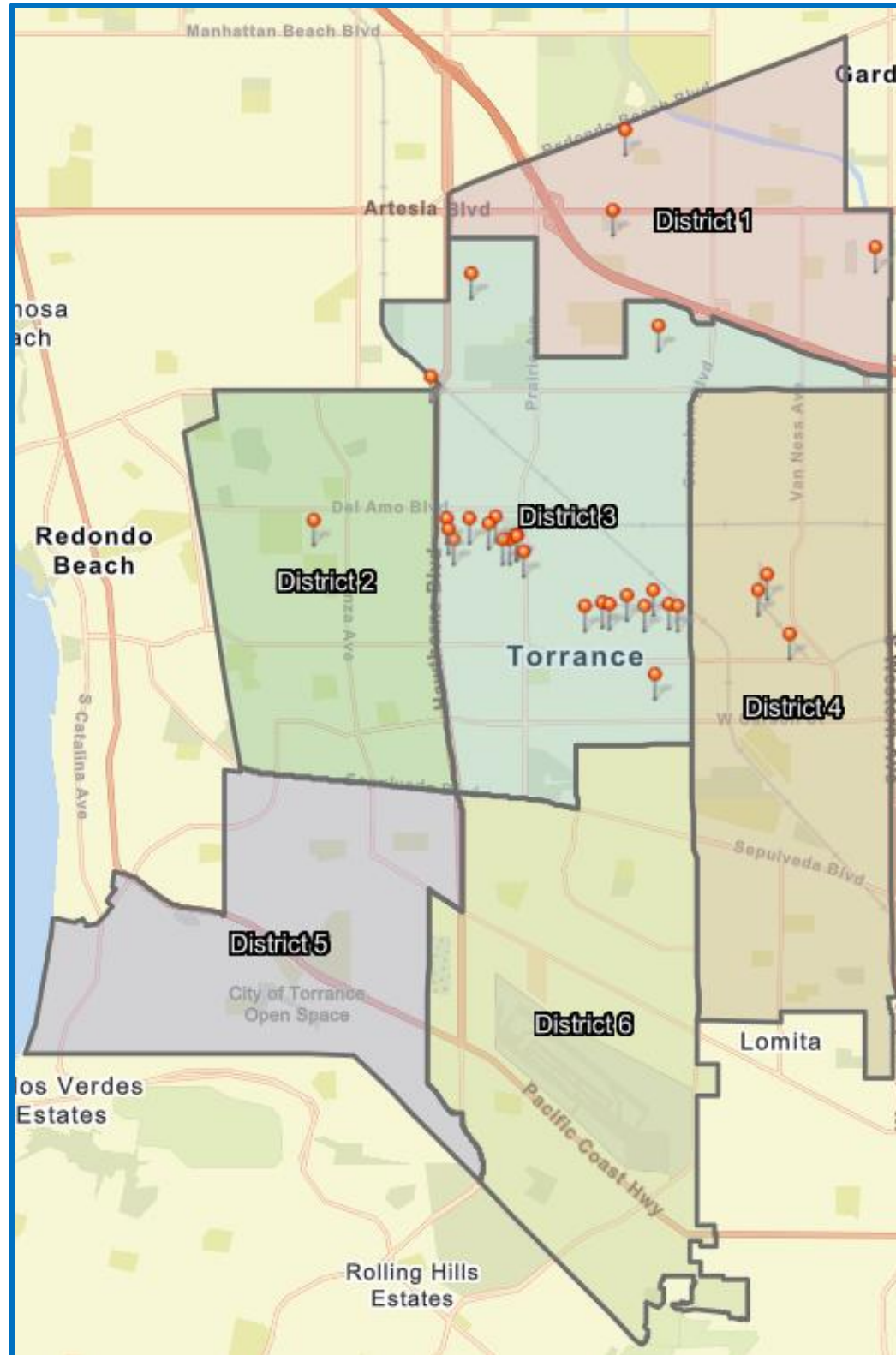

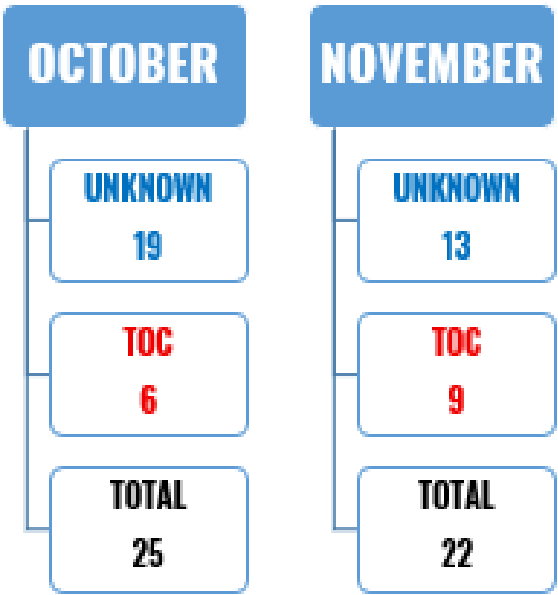
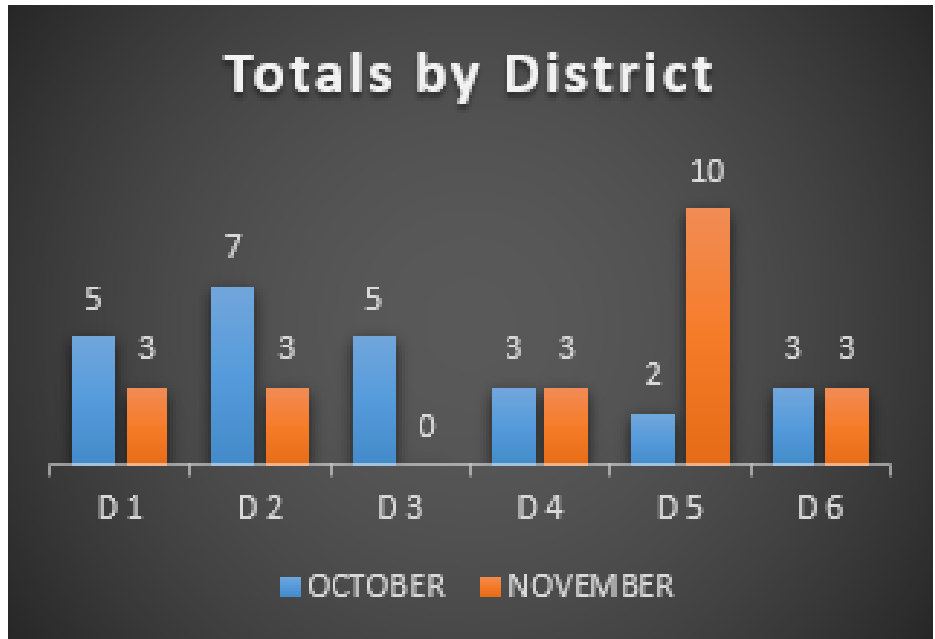
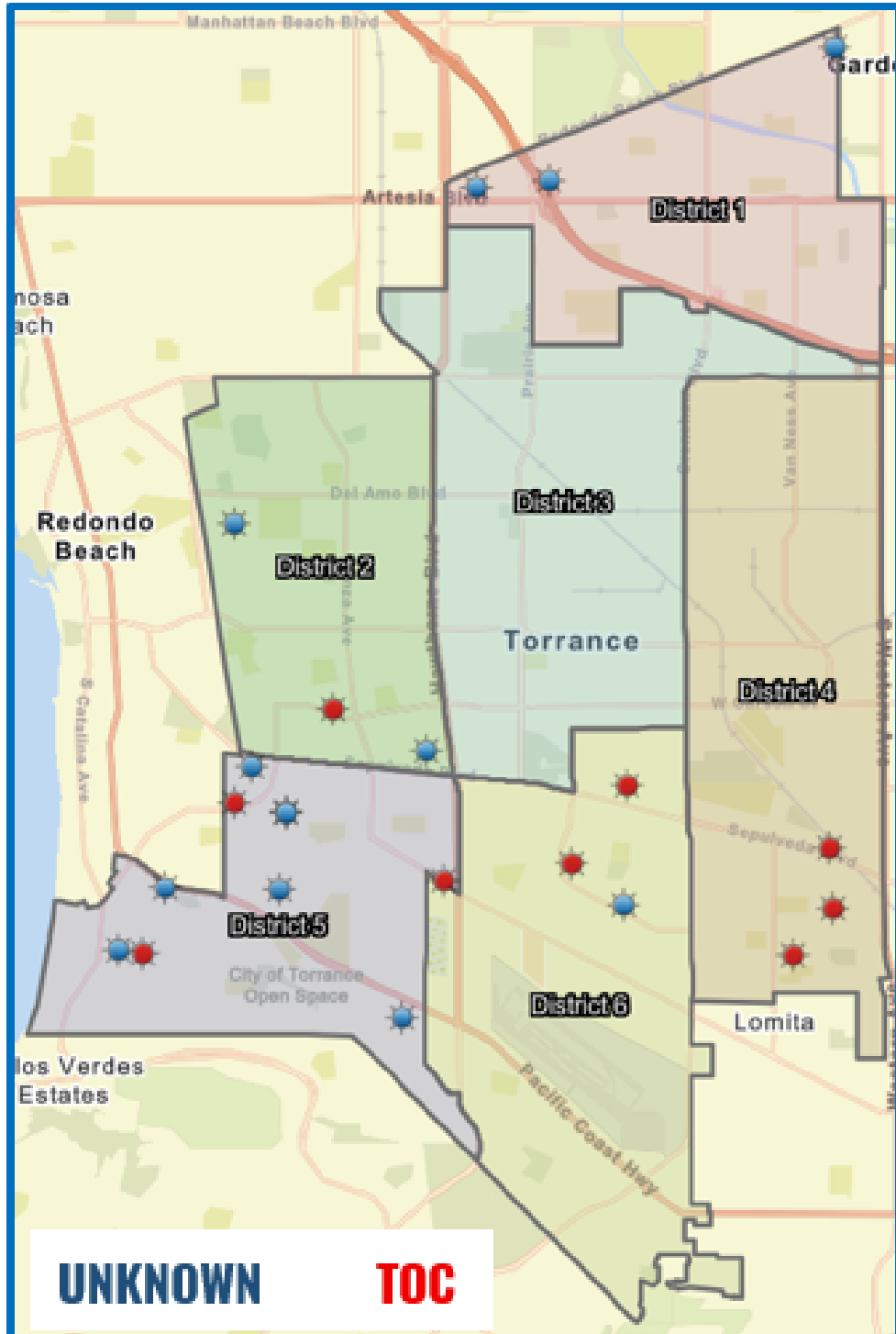
# CRIME TRENDS – EBIKE THEFTS



There was an approximate 20% decrease in ebike thefts from October to November.

Criminals target lower quality locking devices that can easily be defeated by bolt cutters in a short amount of time.

# CRIME TRENDS – RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY



**DISTRICTS**

Increased reporting in District 5

**PROPERTY STOLEN**

Thieves target cash, jewelry and high-end designer bags

**POINT OF ENTRY**

Forced entry through rear glass sliders on first and second floors

**Transnational Organized Crime Groups (TOC)** are associations of individuals who operate, wholly or in part, by illegal means. There is no single structure under which TOC groups function—they vary from hierarchies to clans, networks, and cells, and may evolve into other structures. These groups are typically insular and protect their activities through corruption, violence, international commerce, complex communication mechanisms, and an organizational structure that spans national boundaries.
