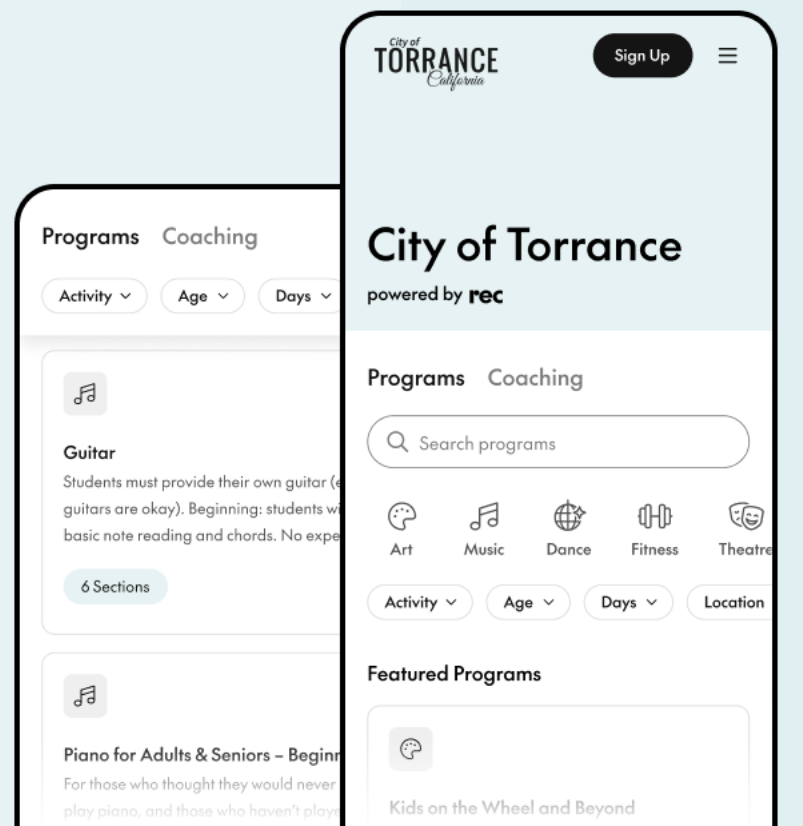

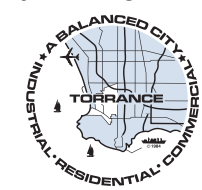

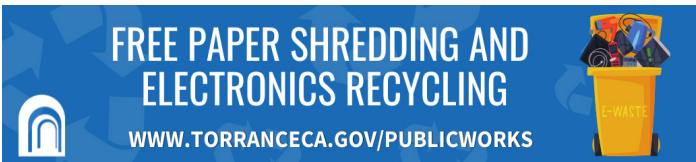

The Victor E. Benstead Plunge is a 50 by 20 meter heated outdoor pool. The pool is divided into two 8-lane, 25-yard and 26 meter sections, and offers a variety of aquatic programs. Men's and women's locker room facilities are available for day use with restrooms and showers.

Proper swim attire is required to enter the pool and deck area. T-shirts, shorts, and street clothing are not allowed. Attire for more complete coverage such as a rash guard is permitted. Please refer to the Pool Rules for additional information. No toys allowed.



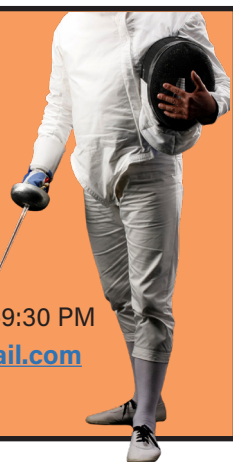

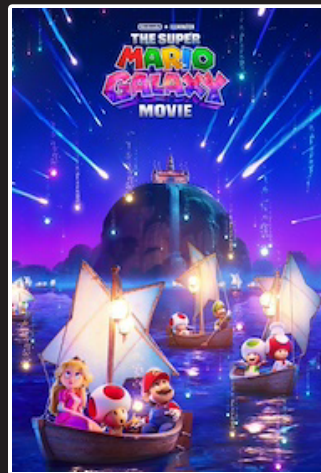

COYOTES IN SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA

Summer Season



Coyotes, like all organisms, go through a life cycle. These stages include gestation, birth, adolescence and death. Life phases are predictable and follow seasons of a year.

During summer months, coyotes focus on their growing pups. The litter of pups, born in spring, are a few months old.

Typical urban coyote behavior during summer, includes:

- **Increased demand for food.** Once weaned from mother's milk, pups rely on the pack to survive. The pack must bring back enough food to nourish the litter of pups *and* feed themselves.
- **Pups learn coyote behavior.** At three weeks old, pups emerge from their den. Over time, pups grow stronger and roam further in search of food. As they navigate their home range, experiences with their surroundings and encounters with people and pets shape their behavior.
- **Coyotes are vocal.** In late summer dens are abandoned and pups explore their environment. The pack, parents and pups, vocalize to communicate with each other and with coyotes in other areas. This is normal coyote behavior.

PREVENT COYOTE CONFLICT

- ✓ **Do not approach or touch pups.** While pups may seem harmless, a protective parent may be near. If a pup looks injured, call Torrance Animal Control (310) 618-3850.
- ✓ **Remove food sources outside your home.** You may inadvertently feed coyote pups. Conduct the [At-Home Coyote Prevention Checklist](#) to make sure you're not contributing to growing the coyote population.
- ✓ **Haze coyotes.** Hazing instills fear in young coyotes, reinforcing fear of humans and shaping their behavior. It deters coyotes from entering areas where they do not belong. It is most effective if residents commit to hazing as a community.
- ✓ **Be wildlife smart on walks or hikes.** Walk with a personal protection device, like a walking stick, noise-maker or trash bag to haze coyotes. Always keep pets on a leash, especially on a hike. Your pet may eat harmful vegetation or engage wildlife, like a snake, rabbit, or coyote.

DID YOU KNOW?

- Coyote dens are abandoned after pups are weaned in late summer.
- Pups practice hunting skills on insects. As they get older, they hunt larger animals.
- Pups learn to hunt alongside the pack at 3 months. At 6 months, coyotes hunt alone. Coyotes are full grown between 9 and 12 months.

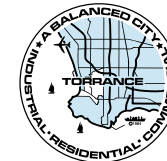

Unfortunately, for the unsuspecting public, illicitly manufactured fentanyl can be disguised as prescription Oxycodone, Xanax, nasal sprays, eye drops and other forms of medication. Only two grains of fentanyl (the size of a few salt granules) are potent enough to put you at risk of an overdose. Naxalone is a safe medication that can reverse an overdose from opioids; however, it should not be relied upon.
