Dear Early Childhood Education Parents,

The goal and objective of the Early Childhood Education Program is to provide your child with a safe and nurturing environment in which they can grow and develop. Disaster preparedness is an important part in keeping your child safe. For those of you that have children in the Torrance Unified School District, you are already familiar with the supplies needed for your child's individual emergency kit. Our program is requesting that you provide a similar kit for your preschool age child.

Below is a list of some suggested items that should be placed in a one (1) gallon zip lock bag with your child's name on it:

- A change of underwear
- A family photo
- Two 6 oz. cans of juice, or a bottle of water. No box drinks.
- Small packets of snacks that are commercially vacuum packed and preserved (examples: granola bar, bag of crackers, etc.)
- Small pack of Kleenex
- Small pack of hand wipes
- Small flashlight (with batteries) or glow stick
