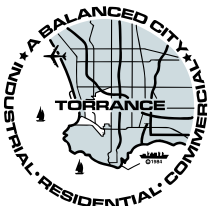

They meet the first and third Wednesday of every month at 7:00 p.m. in the West Annex Commission Room of Torrance City Hall.

Youth Council members are committed to work on such diverse projects as: Youth Forum, Christmas Boutique; ASB Bowl, Beat the Odds Scholarship Program; volunteering and assisting in various community events as well as support the **ATTIC**'s events; Pancake Breakfast, Social Night and MADD Event.
