



Victor Park is 6.64 acres and is located at 4727 Emerald Street. The land was acquired on May 5, 1960. The park was originally called 'Victor Precinct' when it was park in the Don Wilson subdivision. The Isabel Henderson Library was built in 1960. Park groundbreaking followed on June 13, 1963. The Victor Women's Club raised funds for the original acquisition as well as development and tree planting.

The original playground equipment was taken from El Retiro and El Nido parks. This was replaced in 1990 and featured a play bank, jailhouse and metal framed teepee. The playground was again updated in 2008. Victor Park features a picnic area, basketball court, sand volleyball court, softball diamond and restrooms. The jogging path that circles the middle of the park is .19 miles.

The Henderson Library and Victor Park are enjoyed by students at Victor Elementary school and the local community.
