

Youth Sports Prospective Coach's To Do List

- **Coach's Application** – You must complete this application online at: <https://www.volgistics.com/ex/portal.dll/ap?ap=109843487>
- **Fingerprints** – Upon completing your application you will need to get your fingerprints taken, attached is the form and the directions to the place to get you fingerprints done.
- **Coach's Agreement** – Coach's agreement is attached to this email. This form will also be available in the coach's packet that you will receive at the Coach's meeting. It must be signed and turned in by the day of the coach's meeting.
- **NAYS Training** – NAYS (National Alliance for Youth Sports) Coach's training is mandatory for all coaches. You must access it on line at: <http://www.nays.org> then click the Sign Up button on the upper right-hand side of the NAYS homepage – www.nays.org. On the following page you select the corresponding program (coach). You will be bypassing the payment page and disregard the membership costs listed as the City covers the cost for you. It's important you select your organization's name (as noted in the NAYS member organization drop down box) during the sign up process; otherwise you will be charged for your membership.
- **Concussion Certificate** – Concussion training is on-line. You can do it through NAYS or Heads Up with the CDC. It takes about 15 minutes and you can generate a certificate upon completion if you pass – you must email the certificate to pgoldenson@TorranceCA.Gov or bring in the certificate to the Sports Office at 3031 Torrance Blvd.
- **Attend Coaches Meeting** - 2020 TBA

All of the above items must be completed in order for you to be eligible to coach a Youth Sports Team. Please keep in mind completion of these items does not guarantee you a coaching position.
