Requesting families may contact their school counselor if they attend a Torrance Unified School District school to be added to the family assistance application. If their child does not attend a TUSD school and they are a Torrance resident, they may apply at the Torrance Police Department front desk, 3300 Civic Center Drive. Those applicants must live in the city of Torrance and attach a **COPY** of their government issued photo ID card, birth certificate of each child and proof of residency (in example- utility bill or other statement in applicant's name). **The Children of the applicant must be 14 years of age or younger to qualify.**
