NOTICE OF TEMPORARY DRIVEWAY CLOSURE

Dear Resident/Business Owner:

CITY OF TORRANCE

This notice is to inform you that the City's Contractor **All American Asphalt** will be working on or adjacent to your driveway apron in the next 48 hours, which will temporarily prevent you from parking in your driveway. Work will involve removing and replacing the existing concrete or asphalt driveway.

Please move your car(s) out of the driveway for the next two business days, unless you are not planning to use your vehicle during that time. For new concrete construction, residents will be able to resume use of the driveway after curing approximately 24 hours after being poured. Walking on the new concrete is permitted once the concrete has cured for approximately 4 hours. For asphalt concrete driveway construction, residents will be able to resume use of the driveway at the end of the working day once the asphalt has cooled.

Please be sure to observe all posted parking restrictions when parking your cars on the street.

Our goal is to minimize impacts and to complete the work as soon as possible. If you have any questions or need assistance during the work, please contact City project staff listed below. We sincerely appreciate your cooperation and patience during this time as we work to make improvements in your neighborhood.
