



YOUTH VOLLEYBALL LEAGUE COACH FAQs

- Prospective volunteers need to complete an online [application](#). Staff will contact you via email with fingerprint information and forms to be completed. A NAYS coaching training and concussion training is required of all youth sports volunteers. Volunteers must clear a background check prior to their volunteer assignment beginning.
- The 2026 City of Torrance Youth Volleyball league is tentatively set to begin on April 11, 2026. The Youth Volleyball League is an 8-week program for boys and girls from 4th grade to 8th grade, and it takes place at the Dee Hardison Sports Center. Registration is \$89. Participants will receive a youth volleyball uniform shirt.
- Registration information:
 - Tuesday, March 2, 2026 – Resident registration.
 - Tuesday, March 10, 2026 – Non-Resident registration.
 - Friday, March 27, 2026 – Last day to register
- There are two divisions in our volleyball league. There is the Junior Division is for 4th and 5th graders. The Senior Division is for 6th through 8th graders.
- Teams in both divisions are formed based on school and/or geographic location.
- There can be no more than 12 players per team.
- All coaches in our program are volunteers and complete a background check and coach’s training before they can coach. Coaches cannot be requested nor can coaches bring already formed teams into the league.
- Team rosters will be emailed to cleared volunteers after April 3, 2026.
- Uniforms will be available after April 6, 2026.
- Practices are held based on the coach’s availability, but teams typically practice for an hour once or twice a week at the Dee Hardison Sports Center if practice space is available.
- Teams will play one set (3 games) each Saturday of the eight-week season. Game times will vary, and schedules are posted online prior to the start of the season. Schedules are subject to change. Games cannot be scheduled to accommodate requests by coaches.
- Participants do not need to have any volleyball proficiency prior to registering. Our program goal is to help provide an opportunity for children to experience playing an organized recreational Youth Volleyball League. We teach the basic rules, strategies and skills involved in playing volleyball. We also encourage good sportsmanship and fair play.
- Participants must wear the City of Torrance uniform shirt and appropriate athletic footwear to their games. Coaches will meet with the parents/guardians to determine the rest of the uniform.
- Coaches will get a credit on account (if they had a player participate in the league) at the end of the season after City of Torrance equipment is returned in good condition by the deadline. Credits are valid for one year.
