CHRISTMAS TREE RECYCLING

**December 26, 2025
to January 15, 2026**

These dates apply only if you are
not able to use your **green**
organics container



Please use your green organic waste containers to recycle your unflocked Christmas tree. Trees over six feet tall must be cut in half and free of all tinsel, ornaments, and stands. Flocked trees cannot be recycled and must be placed in the **black** refuse container.

Alternatively, the City is offering curbside recycling service for unflocked Christmas trees from **December 26 through January 15**. Simply place your unflocked tree at the curb. If your tree is over 6 feet tall, please cut in half. Remove all tinsel, ornaments, and stands and place the tree at the curb approximately four feet from your automated containers by **7 a.m.** on your collection day. A separate truck will collect the trees.

After January 15, all unflocked trees must be cut in half and placed in the green waste container. All flocked trees must be cut in half and placed in the black refuse container.

The large item collection program will not be available during the Christmas tree recycling program. The last day to call and schedule your large item collection for the year is **December 12**.

Scheduling for large item collection will begin again on January 12.

Street sweeping does not occur on holidays. Please visit www.TorranceCA.Gov/StreetSweeping for holiday schedule and information about parking enforcement.
